CLEVER ENGINE TEST MERITS SAIL INNOVATION AWARD

The first do-it-yourself engine test, EngineCheckUp continues to stack up industry accolades. *SAIL* magazine recently honored this one-step diagnostic kit with its annual Pittman Innovation Award, named for technical editor Freeman K. Pittman, who died in 1996.

SAIL editor Peter Nielsen recognized EngineCheckUp with his Cruising Gear Award. This do-it-yourself test detects oil contaminants, including fuel, water, antifreeze and carbon- or metal-particulates. *SAIL* editors Nielsen, Ben Ellison and Jay Paris judged the awards. EngineCheckUp was also part of *SAIL*'s new Innovation Station on display at Chicago's Strictly Sail show.

By easily identifying key contaminants, EngineCheckUp reflects the condition of the engine, revealing what ordinarily requires expensive, time-consuming mechanical work to investigate. EngineCheckUp works with any four-cycle gasoline or diesel engine, including outboards, inboards, generators, bilge pumps and cleaning equipment. Just one drop of warm oil applied to the test medium and compared to an easy-to-read chart determines the state of the oil and engine efficiency.

Also winner of the Innovation Award at the 2007 Marine Aftermarket Accessories Trade Show in Las Vegas, the kit has been tested for efficacy
